WINEMAKER'S NOTES

At Ravenswood we strive to put what we pick in the fields right into the bottle, and our 2008 Lodi Old Vine Zinfandel is a classic example: Fruit is sourced from San Joaquin County where warm, dry temperatures provide ideal conditions for growing Old Vine Zinfandel. Cool maritime breezes from the Pacific Ocean and Sacramento River Delta keep the nights cool and provide additional hang time for the grapes. The roots of these old vines are deeply entrenched in the ground where nutrients and water are readily available. The result: concentrated juicy berries with bold flavors and texture.

Authentically true to the region and varietal, the 2008 Lodi Old Vine Zinfandel has aromas of dried currants, spice, and notes of plum and wild berry. A long finish, structured tannins, and balanced acidity complete this complex wine.
