WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The 2008 vintage in the Napa Valley produced low yields and a high-quality harvest. A dry growing season with a consistently cool summer allowed the grapes to develop at a healthy, steady pace, resulting in lively fruit flavors. The heat arrived just when it needed to—right before harvest, with the grapes reaching full ripeness and potential. Napa is famous for producing wines with opulent aromatics, robust flavors, and concentrated fruit—all of which are proudly displayed in the 2008 Ravenswood Napa Valley Old Vine Zinfandel.

A gutsy wine with fruit sourced from notable vineyards throughout the valley, this Old Vine Zinfandel is expressive with notes of warm spice and vanilla. Powerful, full-bodied raspberry and blackberry flavors with structured tannins will allow this wine to age, but vibrant fruit makes it perfect for drinking right now.
