THE APPELLATION

Our Mendocino County Zin hails from vines nurtured by cobbly red loam soil in an area known for its short, warm days and cool nights. These conditions create the no-holds-barred, bright red fruit characteristics typical of the region.

WHAT YOU'RE IN FOR

A sinfully ripe Zin that breaks all the rules. Vibrant cherry and cassis are layered with notes of toasty oak. Clove and cardamom mingle together deliciously, resolving into a long, smooth finish.

PAIR IT UP

Grilled chicken thighs, baked dark-meat turkey, and pizza

STICK TO THE FACTS

The Blend: 75% Zinfandel, 19% Petite Sirah, 6% Carignane

Fermentation: Native yeast fermentation, 5–8 days skin contact

Aging: 12–18 months in French oak barrels, 20% new

TA: 6.1g/L

pH: 3.6

Alcohol: 14.5%

Ageability: Drink now or wait up to 8 years
